

Recovery Resource Center Program Position Description Assessment Specialist Mon-Fri / 4 days in office, 1 day remote

Purpose: To work with clients in need of linkage and referral to substance use treatment and complete a variety of assessments, including the Alabama Department of Mental Health approved placement assessment.

Scope: This position interacts with the following areas:

- Recovery Resource Center Leadership Team
- Recovery Resource Center Project Manager
- Multidisciplinary Oversight Team

Working Relationships:

- Reports directly to the RRC Clinical Care Coordinator and Program Director
- Reports periodically to the Crisis Center, Inc. Leadership team

Qualifications:

- Master's degree in social work or counseling;
- Current licensure or certification; or willingness to obtain within 24 months of hire
- Two years of program related experience;
- Must possess an understanding of substance use disorder and recovery;
- Demonstrates an understanding of the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) Criteria and the continuum of care;
- Demonstrates ability to act in a professional manner at all times as a representative of the agency;
- Confident, articulate, and professional speaking ability.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Complete the Alabama Dept. of Mental Health approved placement assessment based on the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) Criteria for clients as required.
- 2. Work with other team members to identify and make appropriate referrals.
- 3. Communicate with treatment providers and community partners during referral process.
- 4. Complete other assessments as needed.

- 5. Understand and describe the ASAM levels of care to clients throughout the linkage and referral process.
- 6. Other duties as assigned.
