

Director of Development

<u>Purpose:</u> The Director of Development is a senior leadership role responsible for leading and overseeing the fundraising, donor engagement, and pre-award efforts of the Crisis Center. This position is pivotal in advancing the organization's mission by developing strategic initiatives to secure funding and engage stakeholders.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Fundraising Strategy:

Donor Engagement:

- Working in an office setting
- Onsite work will be required with an option for a hybrid work schedule at times
- Occasional event work

- Bachelor's degree in Communications, Marketing, Nonprofit Management, or a related field (Master's degree preferred).
- Minimum of 3-5 years of experience in fundraising, development, or related roles.
- Proven track record of successful fundraising, donor relations, and grant writing.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, with the ability to create compelling content for various audiences.
- Strong interpersonal and relationship-building skills.
- Familiarity with nonprofit best practices, fundraising trends, and donor engagement strategies.
- Proficiency in using technology for data analysis, and donor management.
- Ability to lead and inspire a team, foster collaboration, and drive results.
- Strategic thinking and problem-solving abilities.
- Passion for the mission and values of Crisis Center.
